Program Information: The culminating research and studio practices will prepare students for direct transfer to a Bachelor's degree in Fine Arts. The 40 credit Minnesota Transfer Curriculum (MnTC) is completed within the degree to assist easy transfer to any MnSCU institution. This degree may also transfer to non-MnSCU institutions. Please see an academic advisor for transfer information.

Program Goals: The Associate in Fine Arts program at Hibbing Community College has been designed to challenge students to explore a personal approach to a variety of art mediums. The program requires that students develop a specific language to articulate their ideas, methods and intentions of their artwork and the artwork of others. Students will use their understanding of contemporary and historical art to better inform their work and their understanding of the visual systems used in cultures around the world.
